This experience is an absolute world-first and allows participants to experience dynamic prehospital care while assisting the local population in a developing country. 

Our in country support staff are experts in their chosen fields and will support the team through clinical support, translation, cooking, transport and security.


Our team are practicing paramedics and nurses and we understand health care.
